OVERVIEW

As the first BASIS Curriculum School outside of the U.S., BASIS International School Shenzhen opened its doors in 2015 after gaining authorization from the Department of Education of Guangdong Province. BASIS International School Shenzhen offers its rigorous BASIS Curriculum to students of PreK-1 to Grade 12, who are foreign passport holders or residents from Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan. In its founding year, BASIS International School Shenzhen was accredited by Cognia and is an authorized test center for the PSAT, SAT and AP examinations.

BIS·C seeks a dynamic individual to serve as Head of Primary starting July 1, 2023. Reporting to the Head of School, this senior administrative position is responsible for providing outstanding leadership for a community of Grade 1-5 students, faculty members, and families. This is an exceptional leadership opportunity in an outstanding international school linked to one of the most successful and dynamic networks of schools in the world.




THE SCHOOLS

They strive to offer their students the experience of an academically elite American independent school: a liberal arts education in their classrooms is complemented by a rich co-curriculum of sports teams and organizations in which their students discover and develop life-enhancing interests and skills. BIS·C schools offer the intellectually challenging BASIS Curriculum.

Revolutionary and world-renowned, the BASIS Curriculum is recognized as blending rigorous worldwide standards with the ingenuity and creativity associated with American education. As a result, BASIS students are positioned at the very top in the world as measured by their performance on the OECD Test for Schools (based on PISA). Each BASIS Curriculum school offers a wide array of clubs and extracurricular activities, depending on the interests of the students.

Eight years after their founding, BIS·C schools have proven their value to parents and students with an outstanding record of university and college acceptances (100% of the Class of 2021 were accepted to a top 50 U.S. university, 84% were accepted to a top 30 university, and 31% were accepted to a top 15 university). The schools also have a reputation for attracting and retaining talented teachers—especially from the United States, Canada, Britain, Ireland, and South Africa—and providing ambitious school leaders with significant professional opportunities.

Once a small fishing community, over the last 4 decades Shenzhen has catapulted into a global center for technology, research, manufacturing, and transportation home to 12.5 million people. Dubbed China's "Silicon Valley," Shenzhen is the country's most affluent city and is considered the second financial capital in China.

The city is an outdoor enthusiast's paradise with year-round recreation at popular nearby mountains, hills, beaches, and gardens. As the only city in China that provides three modes of transportation for simultaneous comings and goings, Shenzhen is known as the "Gateway to China," offering comfortable and quick travel options by air, train, or ship.
