
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Mission Statement

Overview

Cretin-Derham Hall (CDH) — a premiere Catholic, coeducational high school in Minnesota — seeks an Interim President for the 2023-2024 year as the Board of Directors engages in a national search for a permanent President for this vibrant, dynamic school. CDH, which relies on a President/Principal leadership model, is fortunate to have a strong Principal in place. Located on a nearly 23-acre campus in St. Paul, CDH enrolls nearly 900 students. At CDH, each student matters, each is known by name, and a talented and dedicated faculty and staff encourages these young people to take advantage of the abundant opportunities for growth in order to pursue their post-secondary academic dreams and make a positive difference in the world.

In the beginning, Cretin High School provided quality Catholic education for young men of all economic backgrounds from its founding by the Christian Brothers in 1871. The Sisters of St. Joseph Carondelet established Derham Hall in 1905 as a college preparatory school to educate and challenge young women to develop their academic potential and to appreciate the arts. Today, Cretin-Derham Hall, created by merger in 1987, provides an education rooted in Catholic teachings to young people with diverse abilities, needs and talents and continues the traditions which have always been the essence of Cretin High School and Derham Hall.

Opportunities and Challenges

CDH seeks an Interim President for the 2023-2024 school year due to the departure of the longterm and successful President who will assume a visible leadership position in the greater community. The Interim President will bring to this executive role broad experience in financial management and institutional advancement. He/she will share the community's excitement about the School's past, present, and future. The Interim President will help prepare the School for new leadership in the 2024-2025 school year and beyond.



Specific Opportunities and Challenges include:

- Supporting the Principal in inspiring and leading a talented Faculty and Administrative Team in accomplishing an excellent academic program;
- Partnering with the Finance Committee to monitor the School's budgeting processes and to plan strategies for future financial sustainability;
- Becoming a key administrative player in the beginning phases of a \$10 million capital campaign for sports facilities;
- Recognizing, and capitalizing on, the vitality and dynamism of the CDH community and continuing to build the School's positive culture while continuing to focus on the School's Strategic Plan.
