
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MISSION STATEMENT

The school's multicultural and diverse school community fosters collaboration among students, families, and teachers, nurturing social-emotional skills, cultural understanding, and democratic values.

OVERVIEW

EBGIS is an established educational institution that that has operated at its campus in Emeryville, California since 2018 (following operation as part of a multi-campus school for ten years before that).

EBGIS's mission is to "Educate Global Citizens." The diverse school community is united by an international perspective and passion for learning through the lens of German language and cultural immersion. EBGIS is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and is an IB World School. EBGIS is also a <u>PASCH Partner School</u> with official accreditation by the German Agency for Schools Abroad (ZfA) to administer the German Language Diploma (DSD). EBGIS provides a dual-language immersion program in German and English. A mostly German curriculum is used to develop students' strengths across academic disciplines as well as their critical thinking skills, social-emotional competencies, artistic expression, and motor skills. Starting in sixth grade, students learn Spanish or French in addition to the two core languages.

EBGIS is growing to grade 12 in the 2024/25 school year and offers the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme (DP) in grades 11 and 12, with the first DP class starting in the upcoming 2023/24 school year. Students will graduate with the Bilingual IB Diploma, awarded to only those students worldwide who successfully complete advanced coursework in two languages. EBGIS's Diploma Programme is not limited to German speakers, instead offering Spanish and French language tracks for students who enter the program in eleventh grade.

The City of Emeryville is adjacent to Oakland and Berkeley in one of the fastest growing regions in the San Francisco Bay Area. The Bay Area boasts technology and life sciences companies and is a dynamic community with universities and cultural and family-oriented activities.

As the school has grown and matured, the need has evolved for a dedicated leadership position to oversee the entire operation of the pre-K-12 program in collaboration with the divisional Directors and academic leadership.



CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES

- Shape and articulate a vision of academic excellence. EBGIS families value bilingual education, an international community, small class sizes, and a strong academic program. The Executive Director, in partnership with the Board and the school community, will advance and communicate a shared vision for the next five to ten years. An integral part of this will be developing the program and growing enrollment in the upper grades, building on the recent IB authorization for the Diploma Programme, and establishing EBGIS as a unique program known and respected for its excellence.
- Develop and formalize processes and procedures. As a school that is growing and consolidating, there is an opportunity for the Executive Director to develop and build upon existing organizational and curricular structures to ensure consistency and quality from preschool through high school.
- **Systemize communication.** The EBGIS community desires direct and timely communications from the school to keep the community informed about school activities, issues, and decisions. The Executive Director will have the ability to create and formalize communication processes to ensure constructive engagement with the community.
- Recruit, develop, and retain mission-aligned faculty. The Executive Director will need a strategic
 framework to recruit, onboard, and retain faculty, and provide time and opportunities for professional
 growth. Additionally, many members of the academic leadership team are new to their position and
 will benefit from mentoring, support, and clearly articulated roles, responsibilities, and expectations.
- **Maintain financial stability.** In collaboration with the Board, the Executive Director will strategically align resources to support the programs and seek avenues for raising additional resources in the greater community to provide for an optimal learning environment.
- Engage and strengthen community. The Executive Director will promote a cohesive and inclusive
 community by engaging with all constituents. The Executive Director will support the community
 through careful listening and attention, relationship building, and joyful celebrations with the entire
 school.

The first Executive Director of EBGIS will possess most, if not all, of the following characteristics and skills:

- An experienced educational leader with a proven background in curriculum, pedagogy, and strategic management;
- Excellent organizational and management skills;

- Prior experience leading culturally diverse communities;
- Experience in recruiting, onboarding, retaining, managing, and supporting faculty and staff;
- Passion for a language-immersive, project-based pedagogical philosophy that emphasizes social and emotional learning;
- An approachable, accessible and collaborative leader;
- A community builder who enjoys being an active and visible presence in the life of the school;
- An effective communicator who listens well and effectively relates to a wide range of constituents so that the school community is appropriately involved and informed;
- Legal authorization to work in the United States.
