


#### **Mission Statement**

#### **Overview**

German School Brooklyn (GSB) is the first bilingual German International School in New York City. Dedicated to making bilingual education attainable to all Brooklyn Families, GSB enrolls students with and without prior knowledge of German and currently offers education for Lower (K-5) and Middle (6-8) (with plans to expand up to grade 12).

GSB offers a fully bilingual program that prepares students for the GIB: a dual language version of the IB diploma programme where half of classes are taught in German and the other half in English. Non-German speakers are accepted through 6th grade after individual student assessment. The school prides itself on its truly bicultural approach, featuring German-speaking staff who are fully trained and qualified in that system and a curriculum that is accredited by the German government. It is a place where students learn how to learn, developing both a passion for lifelong learning and the skills they need to thrive in a rapidly changing and increasingly interconnected and multicultural world.

German School Brooklyn seeks a dynamic leader as its inaugural Director of Enrollment and Strategic Initiatives with a start date no later than July 2023. The successful candidate will be a highly strategic, engaged, dedicated, and creative educational leader with significant enrollment management experience who is inspired and guided by the School's mission.

- Manage the ambiguities associated with an inaugural role, the school's evolving administrative structure, including the anticipated German appointed Head of School role, and the demands on administrators in a small and young school community;
- Become an integral part of the school community, building connections with and between the school's adult constituencies and maintaining a sense of the pulse of the school in support of its growth and development.
