Overview

With their first North American school opening in August 2026 and ultimately enrolling 1,500 and potentially up to 2,000 students PreK-12, the Founding Head of School will develop and bring into reality a compelling vision for a school that will offer an exceptional primary and college preparatory education to families in the greater Palm Beaches area. This new school, one of a family of 114 Inspired schools globally, will benefit from significant investment to create a world-class campus drawing on the strength and the expertise of one of the world's largest and fastest growing school groups.

For the Founding Head of School, this role presents a career-defining leadership opportunity. The founding team will carefully shape an educational community based on an understanding of Inspired's ethos that meets the needs of the local market. The successful candidate will combine a track record of highly successful leadership and, preferably, have experience of working in a range of roles and independent schools. The founding Head of School must have the desire to work as part of a regional team, and to build a close relationship with the Regional CEO, and the regional family of schools.

The ideal Founding Head of School will have an entrepreneurial attitude and a hands-on approach to opening the school successfully, with an exceptional curriculum and extensive co-curricular program and an excellent founding staff in place. The Head of School will possess adaptability and resilience, intellect and conviction and a global perspective. Compelling communication skills with the gravitas to act as a credible ambassador to a range of audiences is crucial and will be complemented by good business acumen and personal drive.

Inspired Education's major investment (of approximately \$150M) in the growing Delray/Palm Beaches area will result in an exceptional school housed on a compelling, purpose-built campus of 35 acres with excellent resources. Inspired will completely revamp the current facility and grounds, build new state-of-the-art learning space and configure the outdoor areas around three main buildings (early years, primary, and secondary) and a theater, set among several outdoor and indoor sports facilities (soccer, tennis, pool, gymnasiums, etc.) - with an expected 380,000 square feet of building space. Designs follow two principles: Elevate the quality of the buildings from a design and from a functional perspective (e.g. the flow between buildings) and accommodate pedagogical principles that enhance delivery of the curriculum and instruction especially for the early years and science labs. Designs are in their final stages and construction is expected to begin soon.

The Role
