

Overview

Rooted in a long, rich history and inclusive spirit, Menaul School stands tall in its unwavering purpose to change the lives of students from the greater Albuquerque area, the state of New Mexico, and countries around the globe. At Menaul, students from extraordinarily diverse backgrounds are called to be their best selves, successful college and university scholars, athletes and artists, and skillful citizens of the world by outstanding faculty dedicated to the success and character formation of every student. With all faiths welcomed to Menaul's historic and picturesque campus in the heart of Albuquerque, the entire school community - including generations of grateful alumni – takes inspiration from the school's five core values of Diversity, Respect, Intellectual Curiosity, Responsible Leadership, and Spiritual Growth.

Since its 1896 founding as a boarding school for Spanish-speaking boys, Menaul has set itself apart from other New Mexico independent schools with its extraordinary diversity. Nearly 128 years later, it has further distinguished itself, intentionally and steadfastly, by developing what its Interim Head of School calls "a robust global community that inspires, equips, and prepares students from vastly different cultures, traditions, and socioeconomic backgrounds to be truly World Smart leaders." Indeed, "World Smart" puts a strategic label on a student body in which students from nearly 30 countries live and learn together, guided by curricular and co-curricular programs (including weekly Chapel services and the signature Capstone and Mission Week experiences). These programs stimulate reflection on the meaning and reality of living in a multi-cultural, multi-faith, and justice-focused world. For all students (6th grade to 12th), Religious Studies and Integrated Math courses enrich a carefully designed college prep academic program. Deeply committed to a mission that includes every student's "mind, body, and spirit," Menaul helps students become "whole people for the whole world."

Led by its dedicated Board of Trustees, Menaul School seeks an inspiring, mission-focused leader to become its next President and Head of School to begin in July 2024. The successful candidate will be a proven educational leader, a superb communicator and team-builder who will embrace and celebrate Menaul's history, diversity, and faith tradition while building on those foundations to chart a course for a thriving future. In skills and temperament, the next leader must have demonstrated the capacity to bring faculty and staff, students, and the broader school community together in common cause and purpose.

In addition to joining a school rooted in and passionate about its history, the next President and Head of School will come to Menaul at a time of energetic focus on both its present and future. - Inspire and invest in the development of faculty and administrators while holding them to the highest standards of a premier school;
- Energetically and effectively promote and tell the story of Menaul to increase its reputation in the greater Albuquerque market for both academic excellence and character formation – "mind, body, spirit;"
- Develop and promote academic and co-curricular programs that differentiate Menaul from its competitors;
- In further support of reputational and enrollment growth, launch a strategic marketing campaign, well-resourced and professionally led;
- With the Board of Trustees and other key stakeholders, lead a strategic planning process that, among other goals, ensures that the school's fundamental operations support its international aspirations;
- Ensure consistency, clarity, and effectiveness in internal communications and processes;
- Invigorate Menaul's fundraising through a strengthened development program and the creation of a deep and widespread "culture of giving;"
- Actively nurture and strengthen Menaul's relationships with Albuquerque's Presbyterian churches.
