The ideal candidate will be a proven fundraiser with experience managing capital campaigns and the stewarding of major gifts. This individual will work closely with Palm Beach Day Academy's Head of School and will interface regularly with its Board of Trustees, parents, students, and senior administration.

Having just celebrated its 100-year anniversary, Palm Beach Day Academy's leadership is mindful of the school's incredible history and keenly focused on the future of the institution. A Strategic Plan is already in place and the Second Century Campaign is currently underway, having already raised a record \$30MM in one year. This unique time in the school's trajectory allows incoming development leaders a rare opportunity to actively participate in charting the school's course for the next generation of young learners in Palm Beach.

Primary Responsibilities of the Director of Philanthropy

- Oversee the Director of Annual Giving/Alumni Relations and the Philanthropy Office Manager. Conduct office audit to gauge if additional hires are necessary.
- Build & manage relationships with all constituents and solicit support from all trustees, parents, grandparents, past parents, alumni and community members.



- Build & manage a portfolio of key prospects to move towards solicitation and stewardship stages.
- Oversee and manage all fundraising activities associated with major gifts, annual fund appeals, and fundraising events, with a daily focus on major gift donor solicitation and stewardship.
- Work with the Director of Marketing and Communications on production of all major development publications, focusing on relevant campaigns and leadership relationships.
- This position is salaried, exempt, 12 months and includes occasional events during the evening and on weekends. Generous benefits package (family medical, retirement plan, paid vacations, etc.) available.





Requirements – Successful candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Bachelor's Degree required. Master's Degree preferred.
- 5-10+ years of experience in fundraising/development, with prior leadership roles in an independent school advancement office preferred.
- Proven experience in planning and executing a capital campaign from start to finish.
- Proven success in securing major gifts from multiple constituencies.
- Strong oral, written and interpersonal skills. A comfort level with in-person and virtual engagement is required. Must be able to travel to conferences and out of town fundraisers as schedule requires.
- Experience with Raiser's Edge/Blackbaud and/or other fundraising-specific software highly recommended.
