




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Mission Statement

Central to this is both the academic rigor and the partnerships St. Jeans has created with marquee New York City institutions for real-life experiences. "Jeanites" can be found at Lenox Hill Hospital, Weill Cornell Medical School, JP Morgan, Columbia University, and the Whitney Museum, to name just a few of the programs that prepare graduates to excel in college, in their professions, and as citizens and leaders.
