
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#### **MISSION**

TVS is renowned for its commitment to academic excellence. The School offers a challenging and comprehensive academic program designed to prepare students for what lies ahead in college beyond. - Demonstrate the ability to think strategically while working with other Senior Leadership Team members at TVS, including but not limited to the Directors of Communications, College Counseling, and Enrollment;
- Be a visible and mission centered athletic administrator with a record of prioritizing the needs of student athletes;
- · Be an excellent communicator who enjoys building relationships;
- Exhibit experience as a "nurturing change-maker" in an athletics department;
- Show a deep love for children, both as athletes and students.
