## **Overview**

Yokohama International School was founded in 1924 and celebrates its 100-year anniversary this year. From its humble beginnings with only half a dozen young students, this school has now grown to over 810 students with 45 different nationalities, and faculty and staff from 23 different countries. YIS is situated just south of Tokyo in the safe, clean, and welcoming country of Japan, a proud nation with a rich cultural heritage, great natural beauty, and travel opportunities in all seasons. As part of Yokohama's development as an international hub of commerce and industry, YIS enjoys a local and global reputation for a well-rounded international education, with dedicated faculty, engaged students and a supportive community. Yokohama International School is accredited by the <a href="Council of International Baccalaureate">Council of International Baccalaureate</a> (IB).

Yokohama International School has a strong and powerful mission — Live, Learn, Lead — three simple words that capture the dynamic essence of what YIS strives for as a school community. The school's Guiding Statements provide the anchor that ensures the alignment of their plans and decision making with what they believe about improving learning for all students. Their Impact Strategy specifies areas for action to ensure the achievement of their goals. Also, YIS states its courageous commitment to ensure that every member of its diverse community is respected, valued, and feels a sense of belonging. With this strong foundation of an inspiring mission, articulated core values and commitments, and a measurable plan of action, all members of the community are enabled to have a common understanding of their shared purpose together, fueling their continued success.

Yokohama International School is a distinctively international school, and as an IB World School, it offers the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme, the Middle Years Programme, and the Diploma Programme. In addition, the Global Citizen Diploma was established by YIS in 2011 as an additional high school credential providing a self-directed learning opportunity in which students demonstrate engagement and action beyond the traditional curriculum towards enhanced awareness of global citizenship. This credential is now offered by a consortium of international schools who have followed suit. YIS has a student body with over 20 different languages. More than 70% of its students communicate in more than one language daily and over 90% speak 2 or more languages. YIS supports multilingualism and offers Home and Family Language classes for French, German and Korean. In addition, field trips and expeditions are considered an important part of the curriculum, and a comprehensive service program, variety of sports clubs and activities are provided across all grades.



While having a non-selective admissions policy, IBDP examination results are consistently well above the global average, with an historical pass rate consistently 98 to 100%. The dedicated faculty and staff also reflect the international nature of the community and bring tremendous collective breadth and depth of experience in international education. True professionals, they enjoy working with students, nurturing an environment of dynamic inquiry.

In 2022, the school moved into a brand-new purpose-built campus located in Kominato-cho, Yokohama. The design of the new campus highlights the belief that "every space is a learning space", and that learning happens beyond the classroom. A showcase for innovation and flexibility, the new campus boasts Japanese modern and traditional aesthetics, harmony between man-made environments and the natural world, utilizes materials that are both aesthetically pleasing and ecologically sound and has wheelchair accessibility.

A warm and friendly environment with an active parent association, YIS has a notably strong sense of community. Newcomers are embraced, authenticity is encouraged, respectful interactions are expected. The school has made a genuine commitment to deepening their understanding of diverse stories and to increasing inclusion and belonging across the school.
