Overview

NIST International School in Bangkok is a not-for-profit full IB World School offering a premium international education. Their commitment to building a community of diverse perspectives and experiences reflects their focus on developing students who are ready and ambitious to positively impact their world at NIST and beyond.

Thirty years ago, only a small handful of international schools existed in Thailand, each connected to a single national curriculum. NIST emerged as an option for parents wanting their children to experience and enjoy learning in a diverse, multicultural and inclusive international school. NIST was—and still is—unique.

Working hand-in-hand with members of the United Nations, the first parents, students and teachers envisioned a school free from any one national curriculum programme. They imagined a learning community dedicated to an international education to develop global citizens. When NIST opened its gates on the morning of 13 August 1992, the first 502 students made that dream a reality.

In 1992 NIST became the first full International Baccalaureate (IB) World School in Thailand, and by 1999 was offering all three IB programmes. Focused on inquiry, exploration, reflection and—most significantly—the belief that learning is at the core of the human experience, the IB philosophy aligned with the shared vision of our growing community.

For over thirty years, NIST has welcomed thousands of internationally-minded students and their families from around the world. Today their community comprises over 1,800 students aged 3-18 from more than 75 countries. Their holistic education is inspired by the mission of creating inquisitive, lifelong learners and global citizens, empowered by world-class teachers and curriculum, and enriched by an environment where everyone feels they belong.



Governance

Governance is provided by the NIST Foundation Board. The NIST Foundation Board includes 17-23 voting members, with 9 members, the School Director, and the Head of School being selected to be the Executive School Board. The Head of School plays a central role in this group, partnering with the Board to guide strategy, oversee operations, and shape the school's future. Working closely with the Leadership Team, the Head collaborates with Board committees to support NIST's growth and ensure alignment with the school's mission and values.

The School Director, Director of Human Resources and Director of Finance handle school compliance issues with Thai education law/rules. They attend the board meetings; have biweekly meetings with the Head of School.

Our Campus

Nestled in the heart of one of Bangkok's busiest business districts, the NIST International School campus is located on Sukhumvit Soi 15, minutes from Asok BTS skytrain and Sukhumvit MRT subway stations. The 25-rai campus encompasses ten buildings that house over 90 classrooms and state-of-the-art facilities.

The younger students enjoy a purpose-built Early Years Centre providing a safe, age-appropriate environment that includes modern playground facilities, an explorative garden and shared community spaces. This space will be renovated during the 2025-2026 school year, with an anticipated opening in August 2026.

The Elementary and Secondary Buildings contain subject-specific classrooms, including science and technology labs, counselling and language rooms, art, music and recording studios and two outstanding and well-resourced libraries. Senior students have access to a student-designed lounge, café and multi-purpose area that reflects the principles of modern education and learning research.

The Sports Complex includes a gymnastics studio, sports hall with multiple basketball and volleyball courts, swimming pool, two tennis courts and a FIFA-certified football pitch. Students can enjoy freshly prepared meals from the central cafeteria.



The Creative Arts Building and Black Box Theatre provide a 350-seat theatre, performance and dance studios, visual arts studios, instrumental and vocal music rooms, private practice rooms and a recording studio.

The school has a long-term strategic plan to continually improve its resources and to meet the school community's future needs in terms of learning spaces, health and safety, security and creating greater efficiencies.

Living in Bangkok

Bangkok offers a wide range of opportunities, as Thailand's capital and economic hub, the city provides abundant career prospects in sectors like tourism, finance, technology, and international trade. For entrepreneurs and digital nomads, Bangkok's relatively low cost of living, combined with modern infrastructure and a thriving startup scene, makes it an attractive base. The city is also home to many international companies and organizations, offering opportunities for global networking and career advancement.

The city is filled with luxurious shopping malls like Emquartier and Siam Paragon, rooftop bars with skyline views, and a vibrant nightlife ranging from nightclubs to night markets. You can indulge in a traditional Thai massage, take a cooking class, or even join a guided food or temple tour. Whether you're interested in history, food, fashion, or fun, Bangkok has something for everyone.
