Throughout its 45-year history, ASB has been known globally for being an innovative and future-focused organization. MUMBAI, INDIA

Mumbai, formerly Bombay, the capital of the Indian state of Maharashtra, is the largest city in India. The city forms the world's fourth largest urban area in the world with approximately 19 million people. Mumbai has a deep natural harbor and its port handles over half of India's maritime cargo. Mumbai is considered the commercial and entertainment center of India, generating 5% of India's GDP and accounting for 25% of industrial output, 40% of maritime trade, and 70% of capital transactions to India's economy. Mumbai is home to the corporate headquarters of many Indian companies and numerous multinational corporations. The city also houses India's Hindi film and television industry. Mumbai's business opportunities, its recent construction boom, as well as its potential to offer a better standard of living, attract people from all over India and, in turn, make the city a fascinating and exhilarating epicenter of many ethnicities, religions and cultures.

India's largest city, and one of the world's most densely populated urban areas, Mumbai is also one of the most literate (at 86%, it is higher than the national average). India's leaders understand the important opportunity they have, as a poorer country, to focus on education. ASB expects to continue to make an important contribution to that history.

Mumbai's unique mix of cultures results from the settlement of people of various communities from India as well as from its seaside location. The city also attracts multiple nationalities because of the (growing number of) business opportunities available in the area. The calendar is peppered with the many colorful festivals of its diverse citizenry - from the fireworks and beautiful lights of Diwali to the crazy colors and playful water fights of Holi; from the solemn days of Ramadan to the joy of Christmas, Mumbai celebrates it all. At the same time, Mumbai's challenges parallel major urbanization problems seen in many fast-growing cities in developing countries: poverty and unemployment, public health challenges and poor civic and educational standards for sections of the population. Life there has been described as fabulous and exciting - exceedingly interesting but complex. Those who move to Mumbai need to accept it all. This opportunity will be significantly life and career enhancing, but is not for someone who seeks a predictable lifestyle.



THE ROLE

The new Director of Enrollment Management will lead a small team, partnering with communications, business, and the head of school to develop and implement strategies to engage more families, corporate partners, and the diplomatic corps to boost enrollment. Experience with financial aid models will allow the DEM to create an effective financial aid structure for the ASB market. In addition, the school will benefit from an enrollment management approach that will ensure both stable as well as increased enrollment.

The ideal candidate will bring strong enrollment experience, ideally in comparable markets and locations, alongside cultural agility and a sound understanding of the finances that drive and inform a institutional approach to enrollment management.
